THE HOUSE & GROUNDS

The estate consists of 86 acres, a world-renowned garden, playhouse, pool, Ford Cove, and Bird Island. The Ford Family moved into their home in 1928. After Eleanor passed in 1976, she left behind an endowment so her beloved home would become the property we see today.



THE VISITOR CENTER

The visitor center opened in May of 2021. It features a gift shop, a full-service restaurant, 2 self-guided exhibits, and private event spaces. The visitor center is open to the general public Tuesday- Sundays.



FORD HOUSE POLICIES

Ford House is a National Historic Property, and the preservation team works hard to keep the estate looking its best.

- Ford House is a Tobacco free estate- no smoking (or vaping) is permitted on the property.
- No open flames such as candles, sparklers, etc are allowed.

PARKING
