



The X-Force Fellowship is a full-time, paid opportunity for student technologists and entrepreneurs to serve their country by solving real-world national security problems in collaboration with the Department of Defense (DoD). Running from June 3, 2024 to Aug. 9, 2024, the program matches students with DoD project sponsors to deliver a fresh perspective on national security problems by providing rapid, early-stage technical prototypes or policy solutions.

PARTICIPANTS

The X-Force Fellowship is open to U.S. citizens in undergraduate and graduate programs, as well as recent graduates. Fellows will work on mission-focused projects, engage directly with military and national security leaders, and gain perspective on how their skills and experience can impact national security. The program is open to students from academic backgrounds including STEM, policy, business, and more.

DEPARTMENT OF DEFENSE PROJECT SPONSORS

DoD project sponsors will be matched with a team of X-Force Fellows (2-3) that will provide viewpoints and skills that match the project sponsor's needs. Upon the conclusion of the 10-week program, teams will deliver whitepapers, proof-of-concepts, and/or early-stage prototypes. Project sponsors must provide action officers that can commit 3-5 hours/week to engage with the Fellows and offer guidance/feedback.

PROJECTS

All X-Force Fellowship projects must be unclassified. Projects often include hardware design and prototyping, software development, data analysis and visualization, tech scouting, communications and marketing strategy, or policy research. Successful projects should be well-scoped with a clear end state, and should be achievable and deployable within 3-4 months. Priority will be given to project sponsors that can accommodate in-person Fellows.

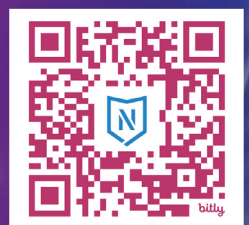
