VALDE GARCIA PRESIDENT, NDIA MICHIGAN CHAPTER



Valde Garcia serves as the Congressional & Industry Liaison for the Army's Capability Program Executive, Combat Logistics. Prior to his current duties, Valde was the Business Development Manager for KBR (formerly Wyle).

He served in the Michigan legislature as a State Representative for just over two years and then for nearly ten years as a State Senator. He is the first Hispanic elected to the State House (shared with one other that year) as well as the first Hispanic elected to the State Senate. As a Senator, he sponsored the legislation which created the Michigan Defense Center, now known as the Office of Defense and Aerospace Innovation. President George W. Bush appointed him to the President's

Commission for White House Fellows. In 2010 he retired from the Senate due to term limits.

Valde also served for 30 years in the United States Army, Army Reserves, and the Michigan National Guard. He retired in 2012 as a Colonel and as the Deputy Chief of Staff for Intelligence and Security for the Michigan Army National Guard.

He currently serves as the President of the National Defense Industrial Association – Michigan Chapter. He serves on the board of the Michigan Military and Veterans Hall of Honor and co-leads the effort to bring the Medal of Honor Convention to Detroit this fall.

He has a Bachelor of Arts degree in Political Science and History from Cedarville University and a Master of Strategic Studies from the U.S. Army War College.

Anthony Owens is the Chief Executive Officer of Gideon Defense, LLC and a Marine Corps Reserve officer with 18 years of service across active duty and reserve service. His career reflects a sustained commitment to leadership, service, and the national defense mission.

Anthony began his military career as an enlisted Marine in the infantry before later earning his commission as an officer and transitioning into the logistics field. His experience across both enlisted and officer ranks has shaped his approach to leadership and given him a deep respect for discipline, accountability, and mentorship. Over the course of his service, he has held roles in both

operational and leadership assignments and continues to serve in the Marine Corps Reserve. He is currently assigned to the Office of Naval Research, where he leads experimentation and innovation efforts.

In his civilian role, Anthony serves as Chief Executive Officer of Gideon Defense, LLC, where he supports government and defense missions and works across the broader defense community. His work has focused on mission support, partnership building, and support to national security efforts.

Anthony also serves on the Board of Directors for the Women in Defense Michigan Chapter as Director of Sponsorships, where he supports programs and events focused on leadership, professional development, and service across the defense community.

He is honored to serve as Master of Ceremonies for this year's ROTC Banquet and to help recognize the cadets and midshipmen whose commitment to leadership, character, and service reflects the future of our Armed Forces.

BRIGADIER GENERAL SCOTT E. HOUSE

MICHIGAN NATIONAL GUARD, DEPUTY COMMANDING GENERAL
46TH MILITARY POLICE COMMAND, LANSING, MI



Brigadier General House serves in the Michigan National Guard as Deputy Commanding General of the 46th Military Police Command in Lansing, Michigan. The 46th provides theater military police support and leads the Command and Control of CBRN Response Element-Bravo, tasked to respond anywhere in the continental United States within 96 hours with a 1,500-soldier technical taskforce to counter catastrophic homeland attacks.

He enlisted in 1994 and was commissioned in 1997 as an Engineer Officer through ROTC, serving since in numerous command and staff roles. Notable assignments include Commander of the 107th Engineer Battalion, Deputy Brigade Commander of the 177th Military Police Brigade,

Assistant Chief of Staff-G3 Operations for the 46th Military Police Command, Commander of the 177th Regiment, and Pentagon service on the staff of the Assistant Secretary of War for Manpower and Reserve Affairs.

He deployed twice in support of the Global War on Terrorism: in 2003 as Company Commander of the 186th Engineer Detachment (Utility) to Kuwait, supporting Operation Iraqi Freedom theater opening operations, and in 2007 as S3 Operations Officer for the 107th Engineer Battalion (Combat) in Baghdad, conducting route clearance and breaching operations against improvised explosive devices, including participation in the Battle of Sadr City. He has worked with military partners from Bangladesh, Iraq, Liberia, Latvia, Mexico, and Sierra Leone, and supported multiple state active-duty missions responding to domestic emergencies, including floods and tornadoes.

His military education includes the Engineer Officer Basic and Advanced Courses, Combined Arms and Services Staff School, Command and General Staff College, Military Police Officer Transition Course, Joint and Combined Warfighter School-Hybrid, the U.S. Army War College, and the Harvard General and Flag Officer Homeland Security Executive Seminar. His civilian education includes a B.S. in Civil Engineering, an M.S. in Engineering, and a Juris Doctor; he is a licensed professional engineer and a member of the State Bar of Michigan.
